



# The Future of Westchester's Parks, Sanctuaries, and Nature Centers January 23, from 10 am to 12 pm

This roundtable is designed for staff and volunteers at county parks, private parks and reserves, and nature centers and for anyone else concerned about preserving natural habitat and wildlife in Westchester. There will be a general and open-ended discussion about the major resources at the various parks and preserves, and the problems in preserving habitat and biodiversity. In particular, the discussion will include the resilience and challenges of climate change.

Actions and solutions that are being or will be implemented will be shared among the participants. The initial goals are to identify the common problems, compile a list of actions that do or don't work, and compile a list of resources and references that will be disseminated through the FCWC website, E-news and through the participants' networks. Future goals will be to organize a conference on natural areas and invite experts to address the issues raised by this roundtable.
